Please read the following rules:

- 1. I will abide by the pool rules hanging at the pool and have read the lap lane etiquette rules included in this registration form.
- 2. I understand I need to pay in full at the time I start my session.
- 3. I understand that lap-swimming privileges are nontransferable.
- 4. I understand that the pool facilities may close for various reasons including bad weather and that I need to **check my email** *before* traveling to Pennington **each day** for possible lastminute cancelations. I **understand I must leave the facility by 9:15 a.m.** Showers are closed at this time, but bathrooms are available.
- 5. I understand that participation in lap-swimming happens only during the scheduled time for lap-swimming unless otherwise communicated from the Director of Aquatics.
- 6. I understand that Pennington strongly encourages only vaccinated visitors, that I must socially distance myself from others, and that it is optional to wear a mask on deck and in the building. I recognize that I am swimming with the possibility exposing myself to Covid-19.

These rules are in place to provide a safe environment, and we hope you enjoy your experience.



Aquatics Center COVID Protocol

It is our expectation that visitors to Pennington are fully vaccinated and will abide by any health and safety regulations currently in place at the School.
