

PENNINGTON DRAMA PRESEASON CAMP

In the spirit of the varsity-level sports camps, the Pennington School Drama program is offering a preseason camp in preparation for this year's Fall Play. Those interested in participating in the Fall Play as an actor, technician, or costumer may take part in a non-residential camp on Thursday, August 24, and Friday, August 25. Housing may be available to boarding students; please contact Ms. Houston to make arrangements.

The camp will focus on the necessary skills of an actor and technical designer for Pennington productions, specifically with the Fall Play in mind. The camp will prepare the minds, bodies, and spirits of interested theatre artists to tackle the audition and rehearsal process, historical background, and design of the show. It will also encourage teamwork and collaboration, which is the hallmark of our program. Students of all experience levels are welcome; not all students may be cast in the production, but participation on one of the technical crews is guaranteed.

No student will participate in camp unless and until all financial obligations have been met and health forms submitted. Health records, the physical examination form, an immunization record, and an emergency treatment form must be turned in to the School nurse no later than July 1. (All of these forms are available on the School's website.) No student will be allowed to attend camp unless all of these forms are in. ***There will be no exceptions.***

Camp Registration and Schedules

Registration for Drama preseason will take place on Thursday, August 24, at 1:00 p.m. behind the Campus Center near the entrance to the McLarty Blackbox Theater. The camp will be held from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 24 (with a potential off-campus theatre trip on that night for a fee), and continue from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Friday, August 25. Sessions will be held in the Blackbox.

Lunch on August 25 will be provided in the dining hall.

Participating students need to wear comfortable clothing that they can move in, and bring sneakers, a snack, a water bottle, a pencil, and their iPad.

Students interested in attending this camp must email Ms. Lisa Houston or Grace Colalillo by August 10. We will then contact them with more information closer to the date of the camp.
