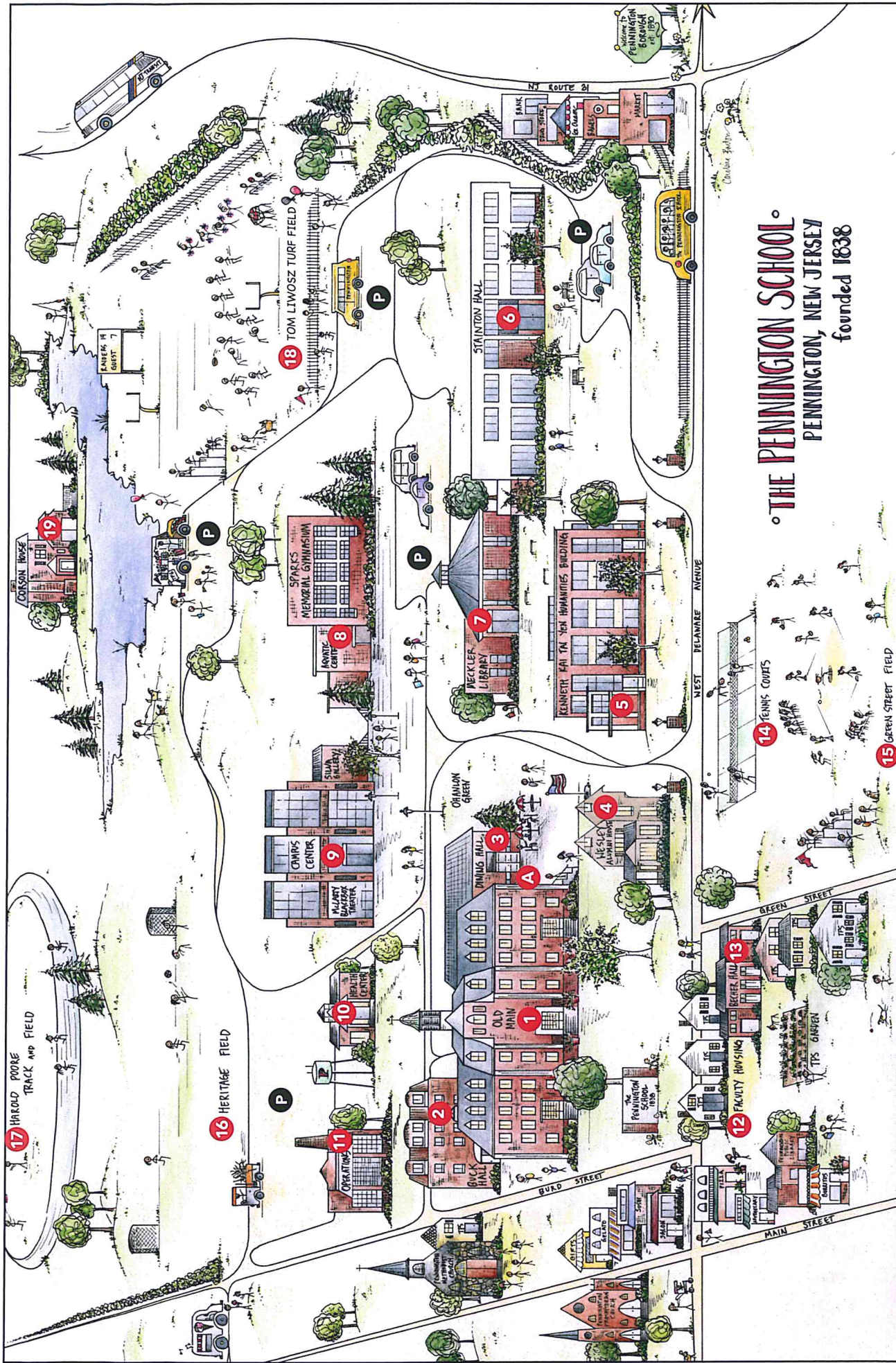

### SPRING BREAK MARCH 2019

#### Austria: German Language and Culture

Spend mornings attending an intensive language course in Salzburg, and afternoons experiencing all that this magnificent city has to offer (and speaking German, of course!). The trip is led by Mr. Peter Chase, and students and chaperones will stay in the same local youth hotel that has welcomed Pennington students for many years. Open to students in German II, III, IV, or V.

#### England: Drama and History

Explore the dramatic arts at one of its epicenters—London!—and perform for our friends at Kent School in Canterbury. Led by veterans Mr. Mark DiGiacomo and Ms. Suzanne Houston, students will stay in a small hotel in London and in dorms when at Kent School. Highlights will include museums, special backstage tours of professional theatre companies, and, of course, preparing and presenting our own original Shakespeare production on a proper English stage. Open to all drama students.

#### Haiti: Service

Provide medical services to remote churches and schools served by Harmony Ministries, help with maintenance of their facilities, and interact with the children who use them. Led by Mr. Blair Thompson through our partnership with the Presbyterian Church of Lawrenceville, students will also learn about Haiti's history and culture, and will even pick up a few words of Creole. Open to all ninth-through twelfth-grade students.

#### Italy: Culture, History, and Art

### SUMMER JUNE 2019

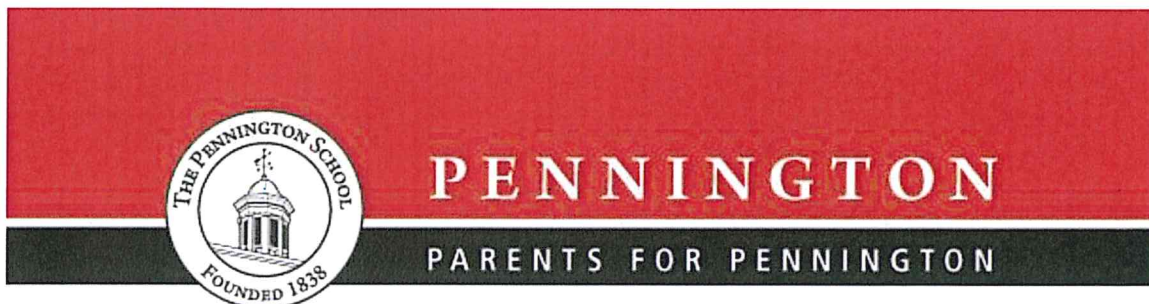
#### Eleuthera, Bahamas: Sustainability, Environment, Human Ecology
